# Crescent Ski Week - Jan. 14-21, 2012

**TERMS AND CONDITIONS** (SAT refers to Sports America Tours, Crescent Ski Council and participating ski clubs)

**Payments:** Reservations should be made as far in advance as possible to guarantee availability. Airline reservations require full payment within 24 hours of booking the flight unless the reservation uses special bulk fares. Reservations made within 60 days or less of departure will require full payment. No reservations will be accepted within 7 days of departure. Reservations without payments are subject to cancellation. Visa, MasterCard, American Express, Discover, Check, or Money Order accepted. All returned checks subject to \$25.00 service charge.

**Cancellations- SAT:** Cancellation of the trip at any point will result in a \$50 cancellation fee. This cancellation fee does not apply to air transportation, lodging or transfer company penalties. Airline tickets are nonrefundable, non-transferable once ticketed. **Trip insurance is highly recommended and is available on this signup form.** All cancellations must be done through your ski club or the Crescent Ski Council.

**Documents:** It is extremely important that you print names clearly and as they appear on that person's drivers license. These names will be used for many of the events, but most importantly that person's airline ticket. If the name does not match the driver's license, that person may be left at home.

**Responsibility:** Crescent Ski Council (CSC) encourages legal and responsible behavior in the consumption of alcoholic beverages in accordance with applicable laws and regulations. Each CSC member shall be solely responsible for his/her consumption of alcoholic beverages and his/her behavior and actions as a consequence of said consumption. SAT/Crescent Ski Council only acts as your agent in securing lodging, lift tickets, transfers and various activities. SAT shall not be held liable for loss or damage to property or injury to person, caused by reason of any defect by any transportation company, lodging company, ski area, agent or any service/item in the package outside their direct control. SAT, reserves the right to make changes and alterations in the itinerary that are found necessary for proper handling of said tours. In the event that such changes are required, SAT will arrange substitute services confirmed for ones of equal or greater retail value, or will refund an amount equal to the difference in retail value between the services confirmed and actual services furnished. Each participant in an SAT tour agrees, as an express condition of such participation, that SAT's liability for such changes is limited as provided herein, and that SAT will not be liable for any additional damages which may be caused by such changes.
