**Please READ this amendment to the Greater Charleston Ski Club By-Laws  
There will be a discussion at the September membership meeting.  
There will be a vote to accept this amendment at the October membership meeting**

#### **Section 4. Application for Membership**

D. Membership alone does not guarantee ones participation in all Club activities and trips. A member's participation in a specific Club activity or Club trip will depend on the member's ability to safely participate. Determination will be made by the Coordinator of the Club activity or Club trip and the Club Trip Director. A member may request review by the Board. The decision of a 2/3<sup>rd</sup> vote of the Board at a meeting where a quorum is present is final.

### **ARTICLE X - MEMBERSHIP**

#### **Section 9. Rejection or Termination of Membership**

A. The Board may reject an application for membership or terminate the status of a Member for any of the following causes, or other causes as the Board may determine:

1. Failure to pay appropriate dues.
2. Failure to meet financial obligations;
3. Misconduct of a Member
4. Any reason applied equally to Applications for Membership and any reason applied equally to Members.

B. Right to a Hearing. Upon notice the affected party shall have the right to appear in person at an appropriate Board meeting. The decision of a 2/3<sup>rd</sup> vote of the Board at a meeting where a quorum is present is final.

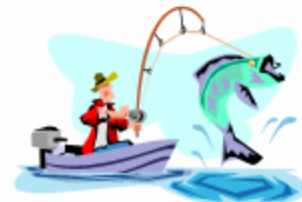
